## YCAGA York Open Premiers August 12, 2011

After several years of absence, the YCAGA has elected to reinstitute the York Open. A special thanks to Don Dimoff and Regent's Glen Country Club for working with the YCAGA to bring this event back to York County. This event has been known in the past as the Yorktowne Open and the York Open. The first tournament was held from 1957 to the mid sixties at Yorktowne. The tournament was vacant for several years and then brought revived and run at Honey Run Golf Club until a conflict saw the tournament discontinued. Briarwood Golf Club brought the tournament back for two to three years in the early 80's.

This event is open to all Amateur and Pro Golfers, with no limitation on residence or handicap. Entry forms will be sent to clubs in Maryland, Virginia and Pennsylvania, as well as specific entry forms to Pros registered in the Philadelphia Section. The Prize fund will be cash for Pros and Gift Certificates for the Amateurs. The field is being limited to the first 120 players.
